Competition Rules and Other Information

- 1 The competition will be a Four Ball Better Ball Stableford Competition off 3/4 Handicap (maximum handicap 24).
- 2 The competition will be open to gentlemen who are members of recognised golf clubs, and who are aged 55 or over on the date of the Competition.
- 3 Members of Huyton & Prescot Golf Club may enter the competition only when partnering a guest.
- 4 The entry fee is £30 per couple (inclusive of 2's, eagles and holes in one). Cheques should be made payable to **HUYTON & PRESCOT GOLF CLUB.**
- 5 Groups of Four Balls with members from the same club will be allowed to play together.
- 6 Snacks will be available on the day of the Competition from 08.15. Competitors wishing to partake of a cooked meal after they have played will be asked to confirm their requirements before they play.
- 7 A stamped, addressed envelope must be enclosed with the completed entry form to enable the organisers to advise you of your starting time. This will be allocated as soon as possible, noting any stated preferences on a "first come first served" basis.
NB. Entry fees are non-returnable once a start time is allocated.
- 8 Prizes will be in the form of Marks & Spencer vouchers, and will be posted to the prizewinners within two/three days.
- 9 There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places, and nearest the pin on the 18th hole.
- 10 All competitors must be in possession of a current Handicap Certificate. A full list of prize winners and their scores will be forwarded to their respective clubs.
- 11 The Club reserves the right to refuse entry of applicants to the Competition. This decision is entirely at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- 12 The Organising Committee's decision on all matters is final.
